GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING FOR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

- ❖ Make sure you meet **ALL** the criteria specified for the scholarship or bursary.
- ❖ Be sure to put the **name and number** of the scholarship or bursary you are applying for on each application for External numbers 44-95. Internal numbers 1-43 require **ONLY 1** application but you must specify **all** the numbers you are applying for.
- ❖ Know the difference between a scholarship and bursary.
- ❖ Ensure you know about the donor of the scholarship or bursary for which you are applying.
- ❖ Remember to attach **EVERYTHING** requested to your letter. Include a letter of reference (if required) and **staple** your application package together.
- ❖ Include a signed copy of the Privacy Statement and Consent Form.
- ❖ DO NOT attach a letter of reference if it ***IS NOT*** requested.
- ❖ Attach a copy of your most recent transcript. (Available at the Pearson Counselling Office).
- ❖ ***Sigma & Power*** students must include a copy of your most recent transcript showing grade 11/12 marks.
- ❖ Make sure any school or community involvement described is authentic and can be substantiated as this may be checked!
- ❖ If the scholarship or bursary requires an interview, you will be contacted only if you have been short listed for the scholarship or bursary.
- ❖ Please ***DO NOT*** put your letters of application in an envelope and ***DO NOT*** fold them.
- ❖ **You must include ONE LETTER of application and the ACTIVITY SHEET for our general file.**
- ❖ **Incomplete or late applications will NOT be accepted.**

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE SCHOOL WILL NOT PROVIDE COPIES FOR YOU. A PHOTOCOPIER IS AVAILABLE IN THE LIBRARY FOR 10 CENTS PER COPY. YOU MUST SEE THE LIBRARIAN.

EXAMPLE FOR WRITING A THANK YOU LETTER

If you receive an award it is essential that the donor be shown appreciation in the form of a thank you letter or card. Please send a thank you letter or thank you card to the donor within ONE WEEK. In your letter, include your name, stating that you are the recipient of the 2010 bursary or scholarship. Extend your thanks for the award, making reference to your career goals and the post secondary institute which you plan to attend.

LOCAL AWARDS, BURSARIES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

The community of New Westminster generously supports its Grade 12 students seeking financial support for post-secondary education through Scholarships, Bursaries and Awards.

ELIGIBILITY:

Please read carefully the requirements listed in the award descriptions. International students are eligible for a limited number of awards, these awards are clearly specified.

APPLICATION:

1. A typed letter about yourself that includes the following information:

- ❖ **Your student number**, name and phone number typed in the upper right corner;
- ❖ The **number** and the **name** of the bursary or scholarship (at the top of the letter);
- ❖ Your service to the school and the community;
- ❖ Approximate number of hours;
- ❖ Your post-secondary goals;
- ❖ Your talents and hobbies;
- ❖ Areas of strength in your studies;
- ❖ Statement of Financial Need;
- ❖ Addresses and phone number of two people prepared to give you a verbal reference. **Letters of recommendation are not required unless specifically requested.**
- ❖ Scholarship or Bursary criteria requested for particular awards in which you are applying.

2. **Internal Numbers 1-43:** 1 (One) application letter ONLY is required for numbers 1-43. **Include on the top of your application letter all the numbers you are applying for.** [Example: If you are applying for #1, 5, 14, 25 you would put the numbers at the top of one (1) application letter and submit one (1) application letter to the Massey Office. You must address the criteria for each scholarship or bursary in your letter or you will not be eligible for that scholarship or bursary.

When applying for multiple scholarships and bursaries, Internal 1-43, be sure to address the criteria for all the scholarships and bursaries applied for in your one application. If your application does not address the criteria for the particular scholarship or bursary you will not be considered for that scholarship or bursary.

3. **External Number 44-95:** You must provide 1 (one) application letter for EACH scholarship or bursary you are applying for.

4. **Sigma and Power** Program students must include a copy of your Transcript Verification Report (Grade 11 and 12 final marks).
 5. Complete and attach a copy of the Scholarship and Bursary Checklist along with a copy of your NWSS Activity Information sheet. ***You must include your name and student number on every piece of paper you submit. You must color in the circle ● on the bubble sheet for each award in which you are applying. Do not hand your bubble sheets in back to back. Each bubble sheet must be separate!***
 6. Include an **extra copy** of the most general application letter to be kept at the Massey office. This is a must!

INTERNAL AWARDS #1 - 43

1. **THE EDNA ANDERSON BURSARY** \$200.00
The applicant must be a resident of Queensborough for at least one year prior to the application. The student must be planning to pursue post secondary studies in the field of education. The applicant must demonstrate community involvement and service. ***AN INTERVIEW IS REQUIRED.***

2. **THE MARGARET ANDRUSIAK BURSARY** \$600.00
This bursary is open to all students of New Westminster Secondary School. Students must demonstrate high scholastic achievement. Students demonstrating an element of need will receive preference.

3. **ARTONA STUDIO BURSARY** \$600.00
This bursary is open to all students of New Westminster Secondary School. Students must be involved in the school and demonstrate a financial need. Students pursuing an education in photography, video arts or visual arts will receive preference.

4. **PARVEEN BARYER BURSARY FUND** \$1,000.00
This bursary is open to all students of New Westminster Secondary School. The student must be involved in the school and demonstrate a financial need. A letter stating financial need and a proposal for post-secondary education must be included.

5. **BEATRICE CAVE-BROWN-CAVE AWARD** \$200.00
This award is presented to a student excelling in one of the performing arts – Music, Dance or Drama.

6. **WAYNE COHOE MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$200.00
The applicant must be a former student of Queen Elizabeth Elementary School pursuing further education. A letter of application must be included.

7. **C.R. DAY MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$150.00
This bursary is intended for an all-round good student, involved in sports, school and community leadership activities, and pursuing a career in this field. The applicant should demonstrate financial need.

8. **DAVID FINNERTY MEMORIAL BURSARY** 2@\$500.00
This bursary will be awarded to one female and one male student who have participated in at least two sports through their senior grades. The students must demonstrate a grade average of C+ or better and include a clear statement of post-secondary goals. Preference will be given to students entering college or a technical school.

9. **ROBERT FORREST HAGEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** \$500.00

This scholarship will be awarded to a student who is actively involved in Athletics, the Arts or Science. The student must demonstrate school spirit and leadership within the school.

10. **HARRIS & COMPANY LLP LAW 12 SCHOLARSHIP** \$200.00

This scholarship is intended for students who have completed Law 12 and excelled in this course of study.

11. **LYNETTE SON HING BURSARY** \$500.00

In recognition of Ms. Lynette Son Hing's dedication to coordinating the NWSS Tutoring Centre for many years. This bursary will be awarded to a student with exemplary peer tutoring qualities, who has been a volunteer tutor for at least 2 years at NWSS.

12. **F.W HOWAY PAC BURSARY** 2 @ \$250.00

The student must have attended F.W. Howay Elementary School for at least four (4) years. The award is to be used for post-secondary education. A resume and marks (C+ and above) must be submitted. 1 male & 1 female student will be selected.

13. **F.W. HOWAY PAC SPONSORED BURSARY-DONNABELLE OLENICK RETIREMENT BURSARY** \$500.00

This bursary will be awarded to a deserving student who attended F.W. Howay Elementary School in Donnabelle Olenick's Kindergarten or Grade 1 class. The applicant must have attended F.W. Howay for at least 4 years.

14. **HUME PARK PAC BURSARY** \$250.00

The successful candidate must have attended Hume Park Elementary for 4 years and be graduating from NWSS.

15. **ROBERT & LILA MCCORMICK MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$400.00

This bursary is open to all students. The applicant must be active in Fine Arts, Drama or Music and show an element of need. Applicants must proceed to further education in any field, but preference will be given to students continuing in the fine arts or performing arts field.

16. **THE MARG MCKEE DELTA KAPPA GAMMA SOCIETY INT'L FOR KEY WOMEN EDUCATORS BURSARY** \$300.00

This bursary is open to all female students of NWSS. Students must be involved in the school and demonstrate a financial need. A letter stating financial need and a proposal for post-secondary education must be included.

17. **DANNY MCLAUGHLIN MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$500.00
 A student who is involved in community recreation in a proven capacity (Parks & Recreation, etc) and who demonstrates a genuine interest in working with younger students through community recreation will be considered for this bursary. The applicant should be a C+ or better student who wishes to pursue this goal through post-secondary education.
18. **MCQUARRIE HUNTER LLP LAW OFFICE BURSARY** \$500.00
 An all-round student proceeding to post-secondary education (university, college or vocational) and involved in scholastic, community, athletic and student affairs will be considered for this bursary.
19. **W.E.A. MERCER BURSARY** \$200.00
 A student in Industrial Education who will continue training in an industrial-related field will be considered for this bursary. The candidate must demonstrate school and community service.
20. **MRC MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$550.00
 This bursary is open to all students of NWSS. This bursary is based on scholastic achievement and the student must demonstrate a financial need. A letter stating financial need and a proposal for post-secondary education must be included.

 This bursary is awarded to assist a student desiring further education or training towards Christian service. Financial need will be considered.

 Applicants must have attended at least three years at Richard McBride Elementary School. The bursary will be awarded to a student on the basis of some financial need and scholastic standing. **A letter of recommendation from a McBride teacher is necessary.** The bursary is to be used for further post-secondary education in any field.
23. **RANJIT MUTTI MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$500.00
 The candidate must be an all-round student, male or female, with a C+ or better average, involved in at least two sports. Further training in any field is required. A letter of application is required.
24. **NATIVE DAUGHTERS OF BC, POST # 4 BURSARY** 4 @ \$250.00
 A BC born female student graduating from NWSS, who is pursuing a medical related career (i.e. nursing, paramedics, lab technology, physiotherapy, pharmacy, dentistry) will be considered for this bursary.

25. **NATIVE DAUGHTERS OF BC, POST # 4 IN MEMORY OF MARGORIE WATT**.....4 @ \$750.00
 Applicant must be enrolling in studies for an educational career of a “Teaching in the Public School System”.
26. **NEW WESTMINSTER KIWANIS CLUB BURSARY**10 @ \$700.00
 The applicant must have a C+ average or better and plan to further his/her education. Service to school or community is a necessary criterion. An element of need is also necessary.
27. **NEW WESTMINSTER LIONS-GARY GARTNER MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$500.00
 Student must be a resident of New Westminster who is handicapped, with a learning and/or physical disability. Financial assistance will be a major consideration. The recipient must be graduating and continuing to post-secondary education.
28. **NEW WESTMINSTER NDP CONSTITUENCY BURSARY** \$500.00
 The bursary is open to all students. The applicant must be active in student and community affairs and demonstrate an interest in Canadian studies or the Humanities. The letter of application must include: community and school involvement, intended field of studies and where intended study is to be done (name of institute). The application must also include a statement about their perspective on social justice.
29. **NEW WESTMINSTER RETIRED TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION BURSARY**..... \$500.00
 This bursary will be awarded to a student who intends to pursue a career in teaching (elementary or secondary, special needs classes, early childhood education, etc). Service to the school and community must be demonstrated by the applicant.
30. **NEW WESTMINSTER PRINCIPALS & VICE-PRINCIPALS ASSOCIATION AWARD**2 @ \$500.00
 Criteria for this application includes honour roll status, proven leadership abilities, documentation of courses and grades, statement of educational plans, application to a post-secondary institute and **letters of reference**. The successful candidate must be a Canadian citizen.
31. **ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION BURSARY**2 @ \$1,000.00
 Children or grandchildren of war veterans and permanent force personnel will be considered, with preference given to war service, if all other aspects are equal.
32. **ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION # 2 LADIES AUXILIARY BURSARY**2 @ \$500.00
 Children or grandchildren of war veterans and permanent force personnel will be considered, with preference given to war service, if all other aspects are equal.

33. **ROYAL CITY CENTRE BURSARY** \$1,000.00
 This bursary will be awarded to a student graduating from NWSS who has done volunteer community work.
34. **ROYAL CITY ROTARY CLUB (CAROL HOEM MEMORIAL BURSARY)** \$500.00

 This scholarship is open to all students attending NWSS. The successful candidate must have high scholastic achievement and be planning to enter a career in the Sciences.

The applicant must have attended Richard McBride Elementary School for at least three years. The candidate must be pursuing further education and demonstrate some financial need.

44. **THE GAIL ATKINSON BURSARY** \$500.00
Students continuing their studies as a lab technician or nursing will be considered for this bursary. Students must have scholastic achievement and demonstrate a financial need. Students must contribute to their school and community.
45. **DOCTOR S. BACHRA – OPTOMETRIST SCHOLARSHIP** \$500.00
Students continuing their studies at a post-secondary institution in the field of science will be considered. Students must be active in school affairs and demonstrate high scholastic achievement.
46. **RAY BASRAN MEMORIAL BURSARY**.....2 @ \$500.00
Applicants must be former students of Queen Elizabeth Elementary School, currently attending NWSS. Bursaries will be granted to two students intent on studying in the field of business and commerce and who will further their education at a university, college, vocational or technical institute. The applicants must contribute to their school and community. Students demonstrating an element of need will receive preference.
47. **CANADIAN PARENTS FOR FRENCH, NEW WEST CHAPTER FRENCH IMMERSION SCHOLARSHIP**2 @ \$150.00
The recipient of this Scholarship will be a French Immersion student with good scholastic achievement who has, or whose immediate family has held a current membership in Canadian Parents for French, New Westminster Chapter (C.P.F.) for at least 2 years. This bursary is open to all students with a grade average of C+ or better. Students must include with their application a separate page describing in some detail their volunteer experiences in the community and at their school, stating where they volunteered and the approximate number of hours. Please include one paragraph including what you know about Century House. All applications must be signed. **AN INTERVIEW IS REQUIRED.**

49. **BETTY BAIN CLOUSTON (NEE: COLTON) MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$150.00
 Applicants must be a resident of New Westminster. The student must have attended a New Westminster school (give details). The bursary must be used for continuing education at a university, college, or trade school (give details). The successful applicant must demonstrate a need for financial support. **A personal reference letter must be included with the application.**
50. **CONNAUGHT HEIGHTS PAC BURSARY** \$300.00
 The applicant must have attended Connaught Heights Elementary School for at least 3 years. A letter stating years of attendance at Connaught Heights, financial need and a proposal for post-secondary education must be included. A review of grade 11-12 marks and **a letter of recommendation (not from a relative) must be included.** The applicant must have volunteered at Connaught Heights while attending NWSS.
51. **THE DUKE OF CONNAUGHT HIGH SCHOOL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** \$500.00
 This award will be given to a student continuing their studies at a post-secondary institution. The student must demonstrate high scholastic achievement with a B+ average and be presently on the Senior Athletic Team.
52. **THE C.E. "BERNIE" CORBOULD SCHOLARSHIP** \$250.00
 This scholarship will be awarded to a student, with high academic achievement, intent on studying in the Faculty of Applied Science (leading to Engineering) at the University of BC.
53. **MAJOR IAN F. DOUGLAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** \$500.00
 This award will be given to a New Westminster student who has demonstrated service, citizenship and achievement, and is proceeding to post-secondary education. Financial need will be considered. **Applications must include 2 letters of reference, one from the school and one from someone in the community.**
54. **EARLY CHILDHOOD BURSARY** \$500.00
 Applicant must be intending to pursue a career in Early Childhood Education and have shown an interest in working with children. An essay is required, explaining why you wish to work with children and **a letter of recommendation from your work or volunteer experience is required.**
55. **THE DR. JASON GALLANT SCHOLARSHIP** \$1,000.00
 This scholarship is designed to recognize a student who has shown an outstanding ability to combine high academic standards with a strong involvement in sports, community service, or other extra curricular activities. All suitable candidates will submit an autobiographical essay of approximately 500 words. The essay must describe "who you are" and "where you are headed" and "why".

56. **G & F FINANCIAL GROUP BURSARY**2 @ \$500.00

This applicant must be making a contribution to the school and community and pursuing further education.

NOTE: Preference will be given to members of G & F Financial Group for one of the \$500.00 awards.

57. **G & F FINANCIAL GROUP BURSARY (TRADES)** \$1,000.00

This applicant must be making a contribution to the school and community and pursuing further education in a trades program (i.e. BCIT).

58. **WESTCOAST GIRL GUIDES OF CANADA** \$250.00

Applicants must present a handwritten letter of application. Applicant must be currently active in Guiding in the Lower Mainland. Former Guide, Ranger, Pathfinder (for at least 4 years). Student to further education at a university, college, vocational institute or other recognized government institute. Outline experience in Guides, etc and include a resume of other extra curricular activities. Obtain application form from Massey Office.

59. **THE LANNY WARD HALL MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$300.00

The applicant must be involved in community/school arts (i.e. music or theatre) and should be involved in sports. The applicant must be employed part-time, demonstrating an attempt to learn independence. An interest in medicine as a career goal will be of utmost importance.

60. **SHERRIE HOEFLICKER FOUNDATION-SHONA MOORE AWARD**2 @ \$300.00

This award is available to a student graduating from Power, Sigma, Pearson ALC or Columbia Square ALC who plans to continue his/her education.

61. **TED HUDSON JR. MEMORIAL BURSARY** \$750.00

This bursary is open to all students who intend to proceed to post secondary education within two years of graduation. Average academic achievement and participation in school activities or sports is required. ***AN INTERVIEW IS REQUIRED.***

62. **INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**2 @ \$500.00

Applicants must be International students enrolled in NWSS and upon graduation attend a university or college of their choice pursuing a course of studies leading to a degree. Applicants must submit a typewritten letter of no more than 500 words describing their academic achievement, their involvement in school based activities whether they be clubs, sports or both and their involvement in the community of New Westminster. Through describing their involvement in the above areas, applicants will explain why they should be the recipient of this award.
